88. Recruitment

Members will recall that YCllr Atterbury and Cllr Eveleigh recently attended a meeting with Mrs Ramshaw from Sir Robert Woodard Academy regarding the recruitment of members for LPYC. Due to the weather conditions, Mrs Ramshaw was unable to attend the meeting in February and therefore will be attending this meeting with students from the academy who have produced posters to promote LPYC. These posters will be judged at the meeting.

Esteem is an organisation based in Shoreham that aims to improve self-esteem and empower young people aged 14-26 years, by providing confidence building activities, events, courses, mentoring and volunteering opportunities.
