

Archaeology of Rampion Wind Farm



Come to hear from the experts about the archaeology uncovered as part of the Rampion project

Rampion comprises a 70 square kilometre offshore site, 17 km undersea cable corridor and 26.8 km buried cable route from Brooklands Pleasure Park to a new substation site in Twineham, West Sussex.

A three-year assessment followed by two years of site investigations, excavations and geophysical and geoarchaeological work has significantly contributed to our archaeological knowledge of the land and under the sea.

From aviation wrecks and paleolandscapes to post medieval-modern agricultural techniques, the finds will help us better understand our past.
