



## CHANGES TO BEACH GREEN CAR PARK PAY & DISPLAY SYSTEM

The Pay & Display machines at Beach Green car park have been replaced with an ANPR system by the car park licensee, District Enforcement Ltd, in agreement with the Parish Council.

ANPR refers to Automatic Number Plate Recognition and operates by using the latest camera technology to keep a constant eye on traffic flow. Situated at the entrance/exit to the car park, the system automatically identifies vehicles and applies the rules of the car park to them. Any vehicle found to have breached the terms of use will be issued with a statutory notice via the post.

The system is provided with an understanding of the Surveillance Commissioner's Code of Conduct for CCTV usage enabling District Enforcement and the Parish Council to operate lawfully and without fear of reproach.

The charging period is from 8.00am to 10.00pm.

### FAQ's

**1** – If I'm just dropping someone off, do I still need to pay?

**Answer** – There is a 10 minute grace period to allow time for a space to be found or to drop off/pick up.

**2** – I have a Blue Badge - how do I register for free parking?

**Answer** – Please register your vehicle with District Enforcement using the contact details on the displayed signs. Please ring them on 01785 336780 or email them at [permits@district-enforcement.co.uk](mailto:permits@district-enforcement.co.uk).

**3** – Do I still need to display the ticket?

**Answer** – There is no need to display a ticket anymore, but please keep hold of it as your receipt of payment.

**4** – What if I haven't got any change?

**Answer** – There is no need to pay as soon as you park, so you have the opportunity to obtain cash to pay before leaving the car park or you can pay by phone (see sign).

**5** – What if I visit the car park more than once a day, do I need to pay at every trip?

**Answer** – Once a ticket is purchased, it is valid for the whole day, ending at 9:59pm.

**N.B.** – *the new machines require the input of your vehicle registration number and tickets are non-transferable.*
