

**Summary of the Minutes of the Keep Lancing Safe meeting

It was confirmed that Barclays Bank estate agent had been contacted to request additional security measures be put in place in respect of the side gate.

Updates from KLS members

- Reports that the back gate and fence at the Library had sustained damage due to youths jumping over it as it was being used as a 'rat run' and that general drug paraphernalia continued to be found around the centre of the village.
- Last week was national Neighbourhood Watch Week, bike marking had recently taken place at Broadwater, Splash Point and Worthing town centre and Lancing's next Panel Meeting was on 28 July.
- No known current asb issues.
- A Local Action Team had been set up by the Police Joint Action Group with the aim to look at ways to keep young people entertained and off the streets during the summer. However, as the LAT had no funds to set up additional activities, it had collated what was known to be already taking place to circulate a list to parents via Sir Robert Woodard Academy.
