

Local Government Transparency Code 2015

GRANTS TO VOLUNTARY, COMMUNITY AND SOCIAL ENTERPRISE ORGANISATIONS

Local authorities must publish details of all grants to voluntary, community and social enterprise organisations. This can be achieved by either:

- Tagging and hence specifically identifying transactions which relate to voluntary, community or social enterprise organisations within published data on expenditure over £500 or published procurement information; or
- By publishing a separate list or register.

For each identified grant, the following information must be published as a minimum:

- Date the grant was awarded;
- Time period for which the grant has been given;
- Local authority department which has awarded the grant;
- Beneficiary;
- Beneficiary's registration number (where applicable);
- Summary of the purpose of the grant; and
- Amount.

Lancing Parish Council publishes this information as a separate list, as below.
