Members will recall that YCllr Atterbury and Cllr Eveleigh attended a meeting earlier this year with Mrs Ramshaw from Sir Robert Woodard Academy regarding the recruitment of members for LPYC. Mrs Ramshaw will be attending this meeting with students from the academy who have produced posters to promote LPYC. These posters will be judged at the meeting.

8. Internet Café

The Internet Café duly opened on the 19 April and on the following two Thursday's. However, despite the café being widely advertised, attendance has been poor and is not open for the time being.

Members are therefore asked to consider the following issues:-

1. When the idea was originally suggested, was it just an idea from one person or was it from other young people expressing an interest in having one?
2. Is it that the Find It Out Centre is in the wrong location for the cafe as it's away from the main footfall of the village – is another location more suitable?
3. It is suggested that a survey is carried out to assess whether an internet café is wanted by the young people of Lancing before a relaunch is considered.

Recommendation – members views are requested.

9. Advertising Local Events for Young People

Further investigations as to how best to set up a Facebook page to allay the concerns regarding safeguarding aspects have been made. A way round this has been found and a demonstration of an example will be given by the Clerk at the meeting.

The working group will also provide an update on their progress of collating the information.
