## Compass Bus Service 16

Due to the withdrawal of West Sussex County Council's subsidy to the Compass Bus Service 16, Lancing Parish Council has agreed to fund this service for one more year.

## Beach Green Lighting Update

Planning permission has been approved to install the 8 columns and associated power supply eastwards along Beach Green's central access track. The project is now well underway with works anticipated to start at the beginning of April 2020.

### **Boat Winch on Beach Green**

A new information panel has been added to Lancing Parish Council's Heritage Trail that allows residents and visitors alike to find out about Lancing's once vibrant fishing industry. With the help of Lancing and Sompting Pastfinders, West Sussex Records Office and the Lancing History Facebook group, the information panel describes the days of old when there were numerous fishing vessels involved in the trade. A renovated boat winch has also been re-installed alongside an existing winch to add to the details of the panel.
