Allotments in Lancing

Grants

Lancing Parish Council makes annual provision to support, charitable, voluntary and/or non-profit making organisations. This year £5,000 has been awarded between four organisations -

Kent Surrey Sussex Air Ambulance

£250 to support ongoing running costs.

Lancing & Sompting Concert Band

£150 to purchase 50 4-ringbinders to store the music.

Lancing Football Club

£1,000 to provide equipment to all levels of the Club's teams.

The Globe Primary School

£3,600 to support fundraising efforts to refurbish the school's swimming pool.

Painting the way.....

Students from Sir Robert Woodard Academy have painted the way to improving the look of the lane from North Road to Monks Recreation Ground. As part of the school's Community Week, the Council asked some students to paint some murals to brighten up an area of Lancing and, thanks to Adur Homes, the murals were given permission to be installed on the northern wall of the lane.



Widewater Gateway

A new gateway has been installed at the west end of Widewater Lagoon to welcome visitors and remind residents of the Local Nature Reserve status. We would like to thank RJ Meaker Fencing Ltd for donating the gateway panel.



Monks Rec Improvement Project

Following a tender process, BDP - design and architect company, has been appointed and attended a meeting with the working group. Residents will be consulted on the final design of Monks Rec in the new year.

Lancing Vision Group

The Parish Council, through its Lancing Vision Group (LVG), is working with many local community representatives who have an interest in Lancing's regeneration. One idea identified is to establish whether it is possible to extend the Queensway design concept onto North Road to:

- create a relaxed and improved village shopping experience;
- have a draw to the village centre; and
- improve the character and appearance of the village.

Members of the group are keen to consult with residents and retailers to gauge opinion of what is liked and disliked about the area at present so the feasibility and viability of options can be investigated further. Please contact the Parish Office with suggestions.
